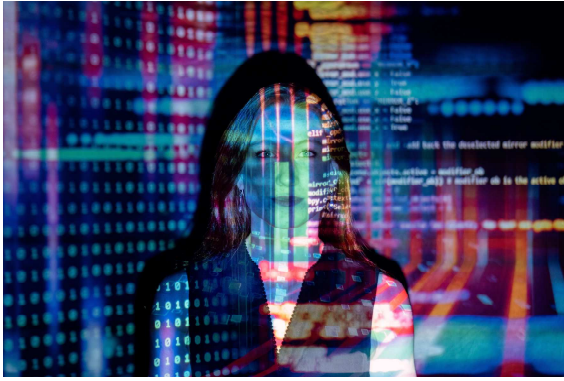

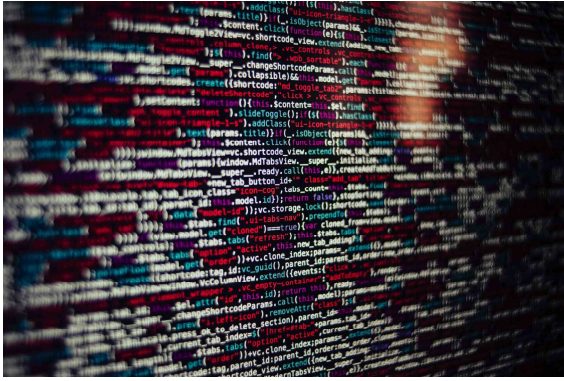
Effective December 5, 2021, **the Bangladesh IP Office has begun to implement a revised fee schedule for patents, designs and trademarks.**
